Students who successfully complete the History & Social Sciences Secondary Teacher Education Program will earn an Illinois Professional Educator License for grades 9-12 in Social Sciences: History. All students pursuing licensure are required to meet with the program advisor each semester . Student pursuing social sciences licensure will have a major in one social science subject, a minor in a second social science subject, and a two course "emphasis" sequence in a third social science subject. Students are strongly encouraged to select their general education courses in consultation with the program advisor, Mr. Bell. fbell@niu.edu Of the seven required upper-level (300/400) HIST classes required for the History Major, one must be taken in each of three groups (A, B, &C) and two must be 400 level courses. HIST 496 may be counted towards the UL elective requirement for the major but will not count as a 400 level course. A student who takes summer courses can potentially lower the number of registered credit hours in the History 495 and History 496 semesters to 13 and 12 credit hours respectively. The same is true for Fall 2 and Fall 3 semesters. Taking a summer course each summer (Summer 2 and Summer 3) would reduce the number of credit hours in those semesters to 15 credit hours instead of 18 hours.

Notes/Comments: This plan is an example of what a four year plan could look like for a typical student. Placement exam scores in math as well as the completion of coursework may change the plan. It should not be used in the place of regular academic advising appointments. All students are encouraged to meet with their advisor each semester to discuss course scheduling. All requirements are subject to change by NIU.
