Qualified applicants are competitively reviewed primarily based on their prerequisite GPA and secondarily on overall GPA and number of prerequisites completed. Admission to the Nursing Program is limited and competitive. Students not selected for admission to nursing, can complete the B.S.in Health Sciences – General emphasis as shown for years 3 and 4 in this plan.
